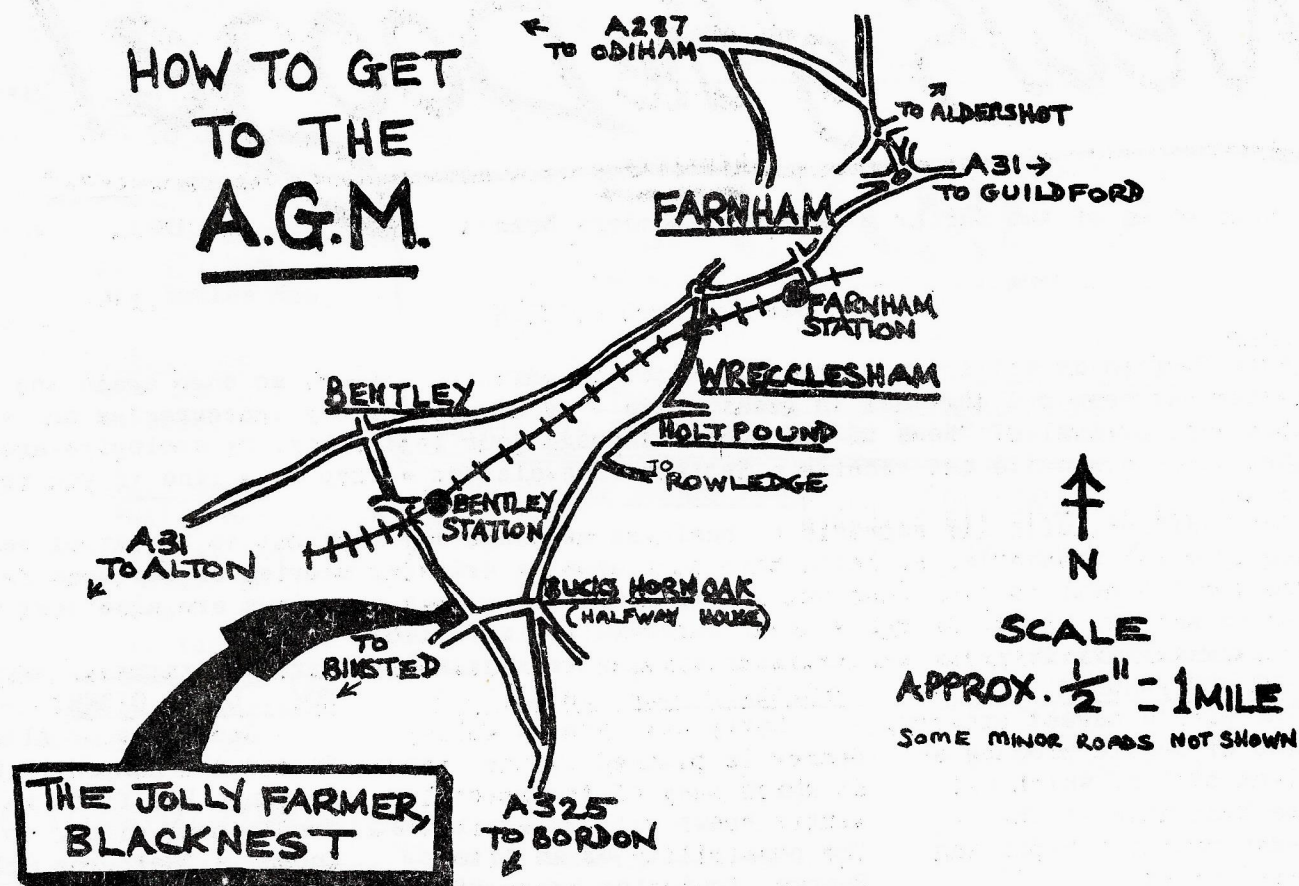






# HOW TO GET TO THE A.G.M.



By TRAIN to Bentley Station:

depart WOKING.....1911

 Ash Vale....1923  
 ALDERSHOT...1928  
 Farnham.....1933  
 arrive BENTLEY.....1939

depart ALTON.....1955  
 arrive BENTLEY.....2001

depart GUILDFORD...1826 ✓  
 Wanborough..1833 ✓  
 Ash.....1837 ✓

arrive BENTLEY.....1939

✓ change trains at Aldershot.  
 (passengers from Guildford  
 may travel on the 1853 to  
 North Camp and walk 1/2 mile  
 to Ash Vale station.)

depart Fleet.....1842 ✓  
 FARNBOROUGH..1846 ✓  
 arrive BENTLEY.....1939

✓ change trains at Brookwood.

ALL THE ABOVE SERVICES RUN  
 HOURLY

THE LAST RETURNING TRAIN TO ALL  
 THE ABOVE STATIONS DEPARTS FROM  
 BENTLEY STATION AT 2301.

(passengers for Ash, Wanborough  
 and Guildford must travel via  
 Ash Vale and North Camp.)

By BUS (Alder Valley 268):

depart HINDHEAD (Huts Hotel).....1945 ✓  
 Grayshott (Fox & Pelican).....1948 ✓  
 Headley (Hollybush).....1958 ✓  
 Whitehill (Prince of Wales).....2008 ✓  
 Bordon (Fire Station).....2012 ✓  
 arrive BUCKS HORN OAK (HALFWAY HOUSE)...2020

From Bucks Horn Oak the Jolly Farmer is just a 10 minute  
 walk down the lane opposite the Halfway House. The return  
 bus to the above places departs from the Halfway House  
 at 2312 ✓ (service no. 225)

✓ Alder Valley have a reputation for running early on  
 Sundays, so be at the stop at least 10 minutes before  
 the bus is due.
